

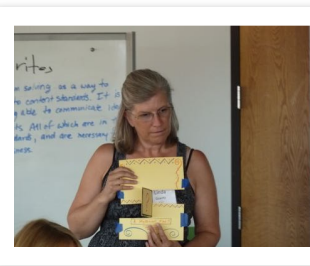
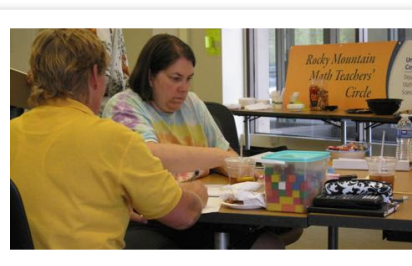
Rocky Mountain Math Teachers' Circle
